


1 Corinthians 1:10-18 - Christian Unity

In John chapter 17, Jesus prays for unity among those who would follow him. This prayer is rendered all the more important when you see the absolute 'dis'unity among Jesus' followers today and in fact throughout the entire history of the church. The disunity of the church is probably the single biggest reason for its failure to attract people to Christ. It is also the biggest reason why congregations split, fall apart and otherwise become factional and ineffectual. "I belong to Paul. I belong to Apollos etc" (v 12) It begs the question, "Why?" Why is the church so divided? Why are congregations so divided?

There are many reasons why this is the case. Paul makes an interesting statement. "For Christ did not send me to baptize but to proclaim the Gospel." Therein lays the problem. Which gospel? Who's gospel? Which interpretation of the gospel should we preach? And there are many. We all want to interpret those questions for ourselves. We all want to preach the gospel that 'I' choose—the one that fits my predilections. Saint John Chrysostom (347-381), one of the greatest preachers that ever lived, said, "Lack of spiritual knowledge is the root of all evil in the church." If this was true in the fourth century, it is certainly true today.

It is a sad commentary on the church that many Christians really do not have a good understanding of the gospel. I can say that because if they did, there would not be nearly so much disunity. The onus upon every Christian is to strive to understand the true meaning of the gospel of Christ and all its implications regarding the attitudes we hold and the way in which we live our lives. Only then can we begin to know the meaning of true spiritual unity. Only then can we know peace with one another and with God. Grace and peace.
