## Epiphany 2 Year B 1 Samuel 3:1-21, John 1: 35-42 – The call to discipleship

The account of the call of Samuel is a great story to reflect on at the beginning of a new year. Spiritually, the times were dark. The priestly house of Eli was seen to have betrayed its calling. With God however, there is always hope. As the writer put it, "the lamp of God was not yet extinguished."



Samuel, the young assistant to Eli, was sleeping in a corner of the temple where the Ark of the Covenant was kept. He heard a voice calling to him in the darkness and so he went to his master expecting to run an errand for the old man. Eli tells Samuel that he must have imagined the voice and sends him back to bed.

It happens a second time, Samuel gets up and goes to Eli. When it happens a third time Eli recognises the presence of God in the voice in the darkness. Eli tells Samuel to respond to the call of God by saying, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening."

This is an example of the perfect prayer of the disciple. We are to be attentive to the voice of God whether it comes in the darkness of uncertainty or in our everyday experiences. As Samuel did not easily recognise God so we have to discern the voice of the Spirit in the midst of clamour of life.

Placed along side this story is the call of the disciples from the Gospel of John. Jesus' first two disciples belonged to John and begin to follow Jesus when they meet him along the way.

What made these two, Andrew and his friend, suddenly decide to follow an unknown and leave the safety of the known and reputable? Jesus turned around and asked,

"What are you looking for?" The two may have been questioning their spontaneous action. Jesus question helps them sort out their feelings. They answer with a question. "Where do you make your home?"


Jesus replies, "Come and see."

To set out on the journey of discipleship does not require anything more than a willing heart. There is only one way to discover whether or not you are discipleship material and that is by living it.




