# Lent 4 Year B John 3:14-21 – Gift of light in the darkness

As you look around you today, it is not all that hard to see that the world is in pretty bad shape. It would seem that humankind, on its own, is completely incapable of creating a just, free, humane and peaceful society. We should not be surprised at that. The Scriptures teach us that it is like this because humankind is itself



fundamentally flawed—not because God made a mistake, but because of the human propensity to sin. No matter how hard we try, we just can't get away from it. And when you think about it, the darkness doesn't only inhabit the world around us—it very often inhabits the world within us.

Every week during our worship, and especially as we continue our reflections during this period of Lent, we set aside time to think about our lives and how far short we fall of what God wants for us. We think of the ways in which we sin—through temptation, through our attitudes, through the negative ways in which we respond to the needs or demands of others.

As we recall those hard things, we realize that it's the Lord who saves us from the consequences of our sin. In spite of the darkness that seems to cover much of the world—in spite of the darkness that indwells us a lot of the time, we know that God is always faithful to us, always loving us, always forgiving us. Even when we reject and deny him, his love for us is constant.

In this light, taking the time to reflect on our sins becomes an important way to get more in touch with God's great love. Where our sins are great, the love of Christ is even greater. There is no better proof of Christ's love than his death on the cross. That's why we take this time to think about our sins. If we bring a heightened awareness of our sinfulness to the foot of the cross, we cannot help but be amazed at the strength of Christ's love for us. Grace and peace.
