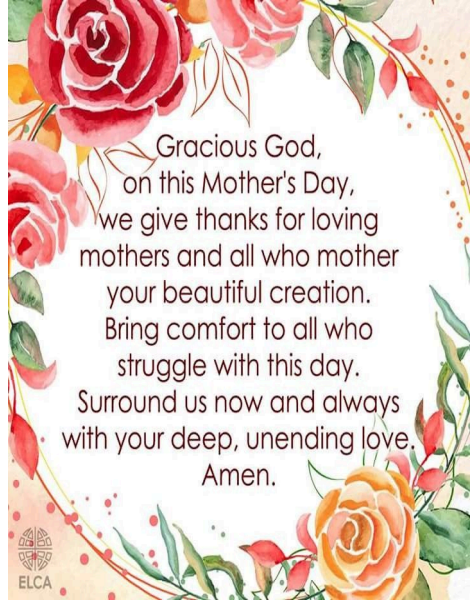

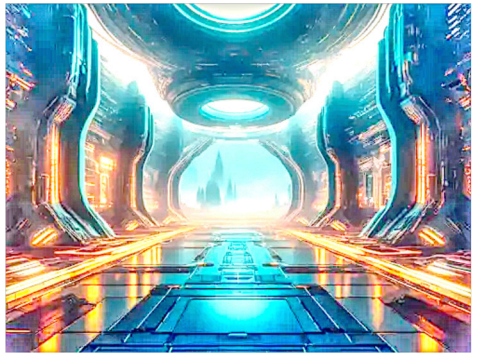

*Based on Acts 17:22-31 – Paul speaks in Athens of a God not bound to temples, calling all to turn and live.*

The first time Elias noticed it, he logged it as a system error and moved on. Level Nine was not a place for anomalies; it was a place for routine, for quiet passage through corridors no one else needed to see. He checked seals, recalibrated sensors and confirmed that thresholds held exactly where they were meant to hold. Every boundary in the city was mapped, coded and reinforced. You did not cross them without clearance. You did not question why they were there. So when the monitor flickered and flagged a presence reading in an unauthorised zone, Elias assumed the fault was in the equipment. The system did not register what was not permitted. That was its strength. That was its promise.

If anyone is interested in helping with the food, please speak with Laraine.

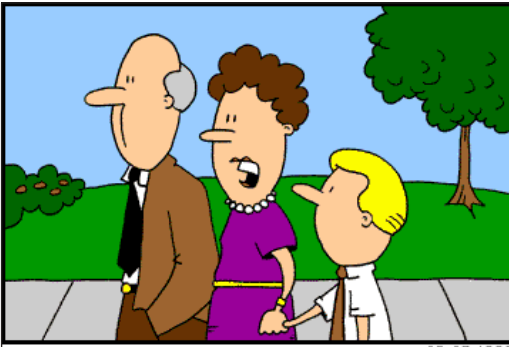

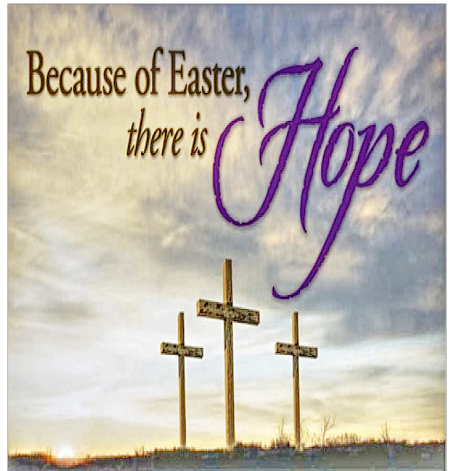
